

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Oregon State Sheriffs' Association (OSSA) is accepting applications for a \$2,000 scholarship, awarded annually to qualified Oregon high school seniors or current college students who intend to pursue an education at a community college or a four-year college/university with a career in a law enforcement field of study.

TO QUALIFY, EACH CANDIDATE MUST SUBMITTHE FOLLOWING, ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1:

- 1. The OSSA Scholarship Application Form
- 2. An original essay, not to exceed three pages handwritten or typed, on the topic:

"What challenges do you see in the field of law enforcement, and what are your views on meeting these challenges?"

- 3. High school or college transcripts
- 4. SAT or ACT scores (if required by your school, and available to take)
- 5. Letter of Acceptance to a community college or a four-year college/university (*high school seniors only*)

 NOTE: Application and any included attachments must be submitted in one, combined PDF file.

THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES WILL BE SELECTED ON THE BASIS OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Candidate's studies and experiences as related to their chosen field of interest with law enforcement
- Scholastic performance in all classes
- SAT or ACT scores (if applicable)
- Thought process, grammatical usage, and ability to express self in the essay
- Legibility, neatness and accuracy of information submitted

Applications must be received on or before April 1. All entries will be acknowledged. Selection of recipients will be made by the OSSA Scholarship Committee. This is usually done by review of the items submitted; however, a finalist could be asked to interview with the Scholarship Committee. Notifications will take place by May 1. The financial award will be paid to the college or university by August 15.
